<p><u>Task 1: English</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite page in a book of your choice. Label the picture with adjectives to describe the scene. Can you use those adjectives to write sentences about your chosen book too?</p>	<p><u>Task 2: Phonics</u></p> <p>Begin to learn the Year 1 high frequency words. Make sure you are practicing writing them neatly, and using them in sentences. Keep working on the correct letter formation.</p>	<p><u>Task 3: Reading</u></p> <p>Read somewhere random. Read at least 3 times a week for 10 minutes each. Read in bed, under the dining table or in the garden. Make sure that you are reading clearly, sounding out and remembering those tricky words. Keep this recorded in your Reading Record.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Maths</u></p> <p>Learn your 2 times tables. Make sure you can count in 2s and multiply by 2! Practice counting in 2s with objects around the home, such as socks or shoes!</p>	<p><u>Task 5: Maths</u></p> <p>Learn all of your number bonds to 20 (16 + 4; 3 + 17 etc.). Make sure you can add to 20, and subtract from 20. Write them all out using correct number formation.</p>
<p><u>Task 6: RE</u></p> <p>Get creative!</p> <p>Create something that reminds you of the Creation Story from the Bible.</p> <p>Remember to upload a photograph to twitter!</p>	<p><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></p> <p>Draw and label people who are special to you. You could even write what you love about them too, are they kind or funny?</p>	<p><u>Task 8: Science</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite animal. Add labels telling us what features it has and which animal group it is part of.</p>	<p><u>Task 9: Art</u></p> <p>Complete a collage using materials that you found outside (leaves, twigs etc) and see if you could create an animal from the story of 'Cave Baby'.</p>	<p><u>Task 10: PE</u></p> <p>Can you throw and catch a ball 10 times in the air without dropping it? What about 20 times to a partner?</p>
