






Cometh the time, cometh the school, however.... This was a school intent upon creating their very own brand of 'New Normal'. A blank slate was the opportunity to create something.







Welcoming. (Whoever you are).




Brilliant. (The Gold Standard).

Christ Church Charnock Richard cares.


They care about staff, pupils and parents; about helping the whole community to flourish both in and out of the classroom. Now, but also noticeably, for the future. The staff pride themselves in sowing the seeds for futures that they may never, ever take credit for.

Leadership is a term often heralded as the catalyst for transformation. In this respect, Christ Church Charnock Richard is exceptional; all staff lead by example form the newest to most senior members of staff.



A recurring theme from interviewing the children was that they genuinely look forward to attending school. The curriculum (and extra curriculum) are woven with creativity, intrigue and magic, but it's not just what's taught that counts. Several pupils talked about their teachers in glowing terms, describing them as 2%ers. The positive attitudes of staff members throughout the school are contagious, creating a culture that bolsters the mental health and wellbeing of all.

In one of the most testing years in human memory, it's poignant to hear them talk of the real and continuing challenges they have faced; individually and collectively; personally, and professionally. 
