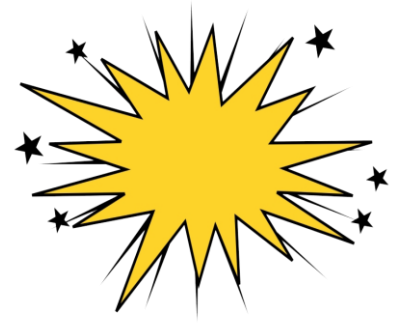
NETBALL

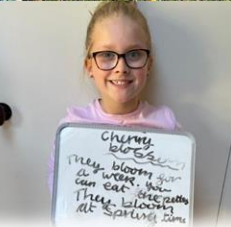
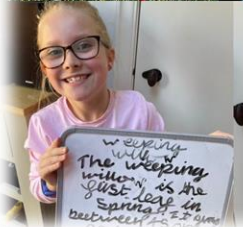
