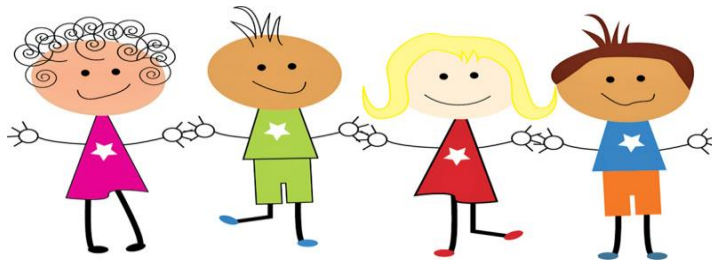

Year 3/4 CCCR team came 2nd in the Golfways competition – well done to everyone who took part!

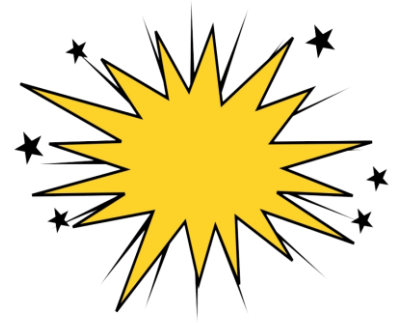
