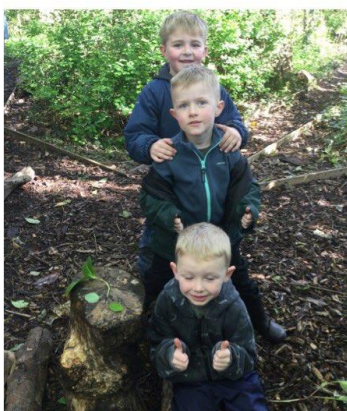
GO OUTDOORS HOMEWORK - WELL DONE EVERYONE!
