Year 2 have been busy this morning creating their things to sell at the Christmas fair.



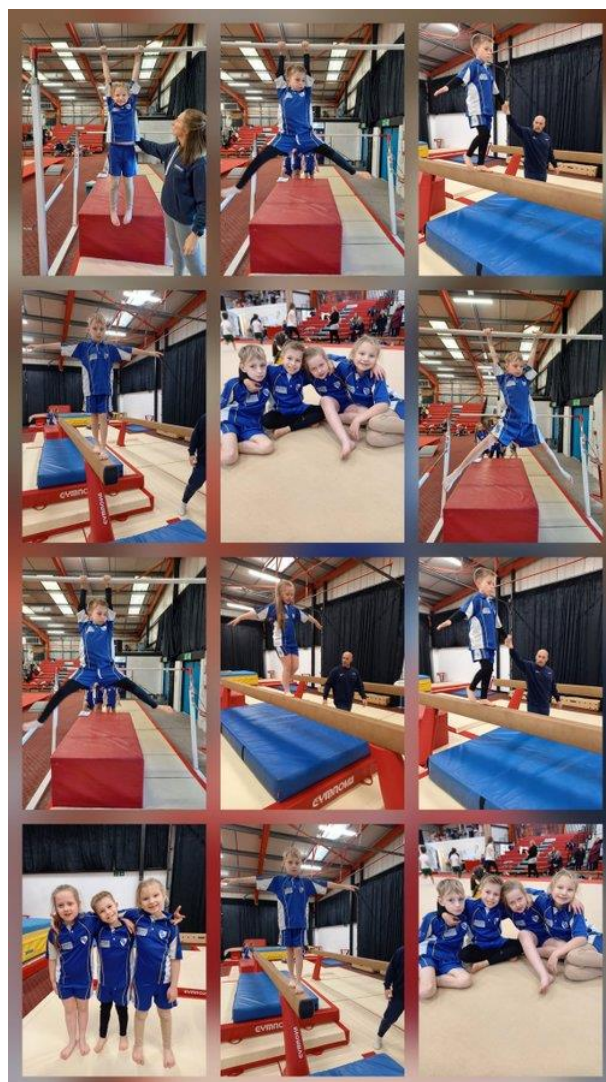
