

Happy New Year!

Year 3 are learning all about fire this term. Today, in our snowy and icy woodland garden, we investigated which sticks might help to light a fire. We discovered that they wouldn't work because they were too wet, too big, and we didn't have anything to catch a spark. Sam then showed the children a few different ways to light a fire, and they chose one method to experiment with this week (a Jenga-style structure). We also talked about how to put fires out safely.

In addition, the children examined partially eaten apples and worked out that they had been eaten by squirrels. They also enjoyed building dens and playing battalions, developing teamwork, imagination, and outdoor skills.
