Although the afternoon session was too windy to work with fire in the woods, that certainly didn't stop the fun! The children got creative by making woodland creatures and their own fire dishes from clay, collected more dead wood, and practised fire-lighting techniques on the playground. We also had thoughtful discussions about the different safety considerations that would be needed if a fire were lit in that space.

To finish the day, the children let off some energy with some very enthusiastic games of Chaos Tag on the field. A fantastic week of learning, creativity and outdoor fun!



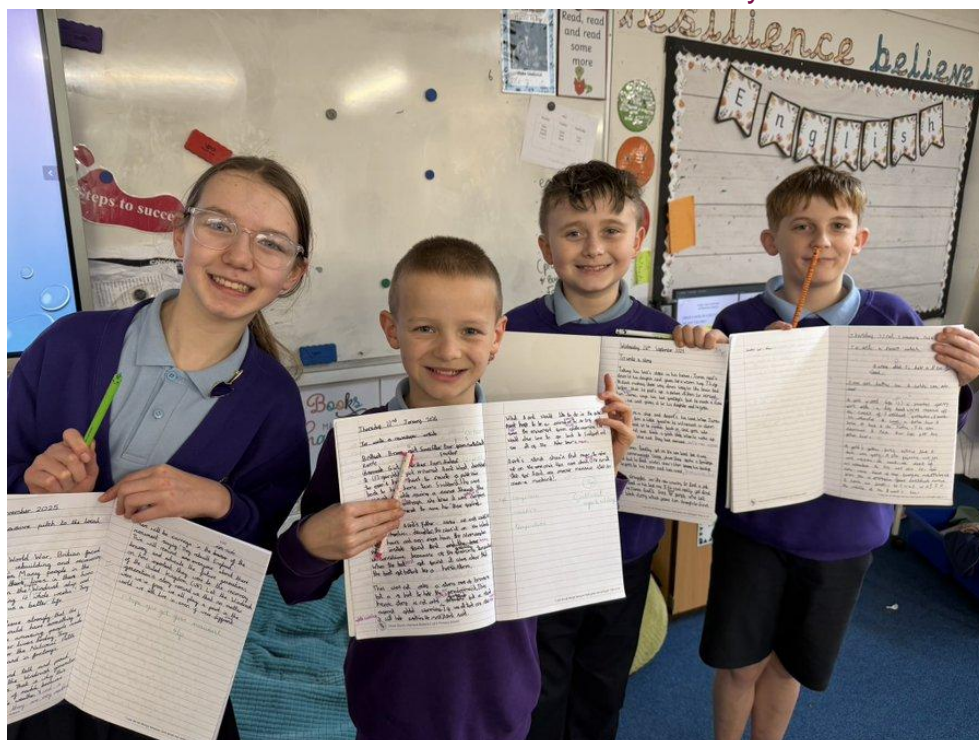
ECO TOWN
