

Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter

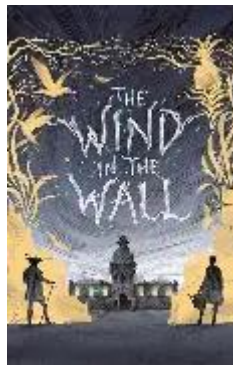
Summer Term 2026

Welcome back to school, I hope you have had a lovely and peaceful Easter Holidays. This is your child's final term at Christ Church - it will be a very busy, fun and a super enjoyable term. I am going to make it as special as I can as they are all brilliant and deserve the best final term ever.

English

Reading we will be reading a vast variety of texts and extracts from books in preparation for SATs - please ensure your child is reading at home for at least 3 sessions a week for at least 30 minutes.

Writing lessons will be based on *The Wind in the Wall* by Sally Gardner. We will be writing extended narratives and character descriptions.



Maths: The focus this term will be revisiting and refreshing arithmetic skills and reasoning problems.

Please encourage your child to continue to rock out on TT Rock Stars. Let's take over the leader board.

History: Unheard histories: Who should go on the banknote?

We will be naming the features of a banknote and making inferences about a person using a banknote. Additionally, we will be investigating the significance of historical figures.

Science: Science this term will be 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will study inherited characteristics, natural selection and how animals including humans have evolved over time.

DT (Textiles): Reduce, recycle and repurpose. We will be making a teddy bear out of an old school jumper. We will also be discussing the incredible recycling work of Isatou Ceesay. **Please send into school a jumper for this project**

RE : What is the nature and character of God? We will look at deepening our understanding of the Christian beliefs about the nature of God, his character and his relationships with people.

PE: Athletics: running (600m and 100m), jumping (standing long jump) and throwing (vortex).
