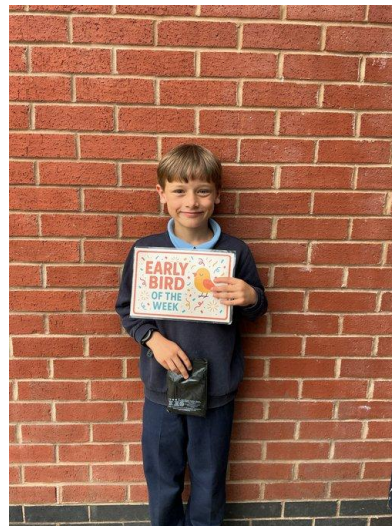

## FOREST SCHOOL

Here is a look at what we've been up to during our action-packed start to the term:

### Wild Passport: The Nature Module & Wildlife Tracking

We officially launched our Wild Passport curriculum this week, focusing on our nature module. The children turned into mini-botanists, exploring the woodland garden to identify various trees and bushes. They did a fantastic job spotting different leaf shapes and bark textures, learning more about the rich ecosystem right on our doorstep.

We also turned our attention to the tiny creatures that share our woods:

**Five-Star Bug Hotels:** The children got creative building cozy "bug hotels" using twigs, moss, and bark to encourage more mini-beasts to move into our garden.

**The Secret Doorway Test:** While exploring, we discovered some mysterious animal holes in the woods! To figure out if anyone is currently at home, we gently placed a few loose leaves near the entrances. If the leaves have moved by next week, we'll know a furry resident has been pushing past them!

### Camp Craft & Engineering

**Mastering the Canopy:** Teamwork makes the dream work! The children learned the vital skill of how to put up our large shelter canopy and—just as importantly—how to safely take it down again.

**Natural Umbrellas:** Proving that resourcefulness is second nature to them, a few of our young inventors crafted their own working umbrellas using just sticks and large leaves.

### Creativity, Commerce & Exploration

**The Woodland Shop:** Imagination took over as the children built a fully functioning mud-and-stick shop. They even designed a complete "ordering system" for their customers. Watch out, Amazon!

**Tree Sap Discovery:** While exploring, we found fresh tree sap. This sparked a fascinating, child-led discussion about what sap actually is and what it means for the health and life of the tree.

**Conquering the Climbing Tree:** Confidence is soaring! Many of our learners tested their strength and agility by tackling the climbing tree, cheering each other on every step of the way.

### Looking Ahead: Garden Designers

We aren't just playing in the woods—we're taking ownership of them. The children have officially started planning what improvements they want to make to the woodland garden this term. Stay tuned to see their designs come to life!
